

ORDINANCE NO. 854

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 50, SECTION
50.08 A SERVICE FEES OF THE ETOWAH MUNICIPAL CODE.**

WHEREAS, Chapter 50 of the City of Etowah Municipal Code established the rules and regulations regarding refuse and trash; and

WHEREAS, such rules and regulations need to be amended from time to time to clarify regulations and to provide for operating efficiencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ETOWAH

50.06 CONSTRUCTION AND REMODELING MATERIAL; MOBILE COLLECTION TRAILERS.

B (2) The use of mobile sanitation collection trailers will be a "pay per use" service provided to citizens and contractors working on houses and properties inside the city limits. The "pay per use" fees;

(a) Residents: \$75 use fee, plus the current landfill weighted cost per ton of material; and

(b) Contractors: \$125 use fee, plus the current landfill weighted cost per ton of material.

50.08 SERVICES FEES

(A) The cost for residential refuse/garbage disposal shall be \$15.15 per month per dwelling unit, payable monthly to the Utility Department.

(B) The Commercial rates shall be based on yardage of dumpster, if dumpster is shared or single use and on volume of sanitation collected.

a. Base rate of \$ 37.000 shall be changed to all commercial accounts that have chosen to contract out of city services for their sanitation.

b. Minimal dumpster fees are set as follows:

i. 3.5-yard dumpster service fee	\$ 103.00 Per month
ii. 3.5 yard with dumpster rental	\$ 123.00 Per month
iii. 4-yard dumpster service fee	\$ 111.00 Per month
iv. 4-yard dumpster with rental	\$ 131.00 Per month
v. 6-yard dumpster service fee	\$ 145.00 Per month
vi. 6-yard dumpster with rental	\$ 165.00 Per month
vii. 8-yard dumpster service fee	\$ 175.00 Per month
viii. 8-yard dumpster with rental	\$ 195.00 Per month


Custom services shall be based on the base and minimal dumpster fees and provided to the Etowah Utility Board on an annual basis and as new customers are established for sanitation services.

This ordinance shall take effect with the final passing of the 2020 – 2021 Fiscal Budget.


